How Do I Apply?

Becoming a SEA Lab volunteer is a simple process! Here's how:

- Speak to the Volunteer Programs Supervisor about available volunteer positions
- Complete an application
- Attend an orientation session

Do I qualify?

- If you are at least 14-years old and can commit to the SEA Lab for at least 6 months (volunteer for at least 8 hours a month), then, yes, you qualify!

When Will I Begin?

Once we have received your SEA Lab volunteer application, we will invite you to attend the next available volunteer orientation. At the orientation you will learn about our programs, go on a facility tour and have the opportunity to ask questions about volunteering at the SEA Lab. Your start date depends on your interests, position availability and our training schedule.

No experience necessary. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a volunteering adult. All participants must sign a waiver at the time of service.
